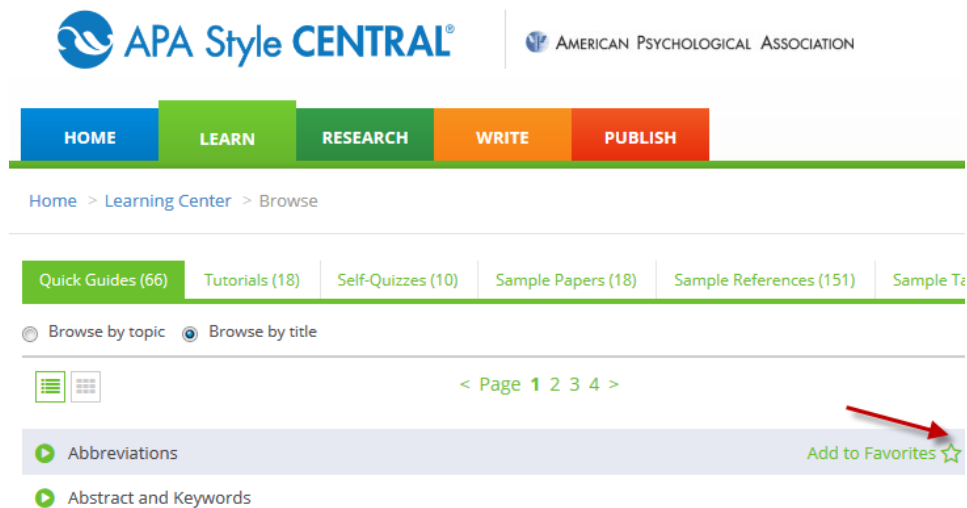


## APA Style CENTRAL® – Saving Favorite Items in the Learning Center

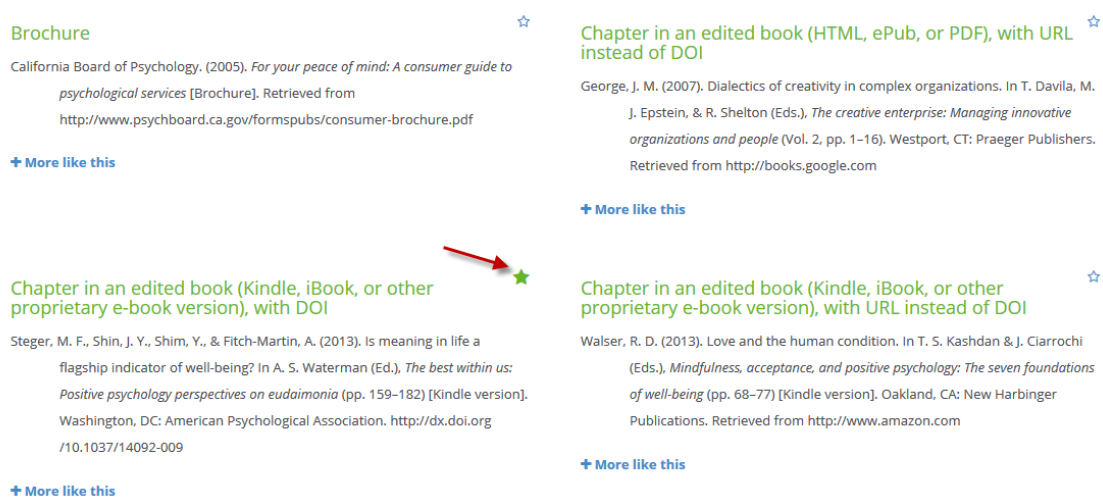
Any object in the Learning Center can be marked as a “favorite” and saved to your personal list for later use, similar to bookmarks in a browser. Favorites can include Quick Guides, Tutorials, Self-Quizzes, Sample Papers, Sample References, Sample Tables, and Sample Figures. Favorites are stored in a section of the Learning Center called **My Favorites**.

If you want to save a Learning Object for future access, click on the star beside it to **Add to Favorites**.




You will be prompted to log in to your individual account, if you have not already.

If you are browsing the Learning Center while logged in to your account, you can see which Learning Objects you’ve already added to **My Favorites**, by noting the colored star.




You can view the list of **My Favorites** within the Learning Center. Selecting one Learning Object from the list of favorites allows you to view the Description, Thumbnail, Learn More, and More Like this for that item. To open the favorite, click the thumbnail.



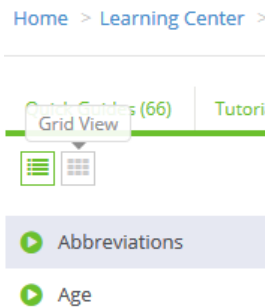

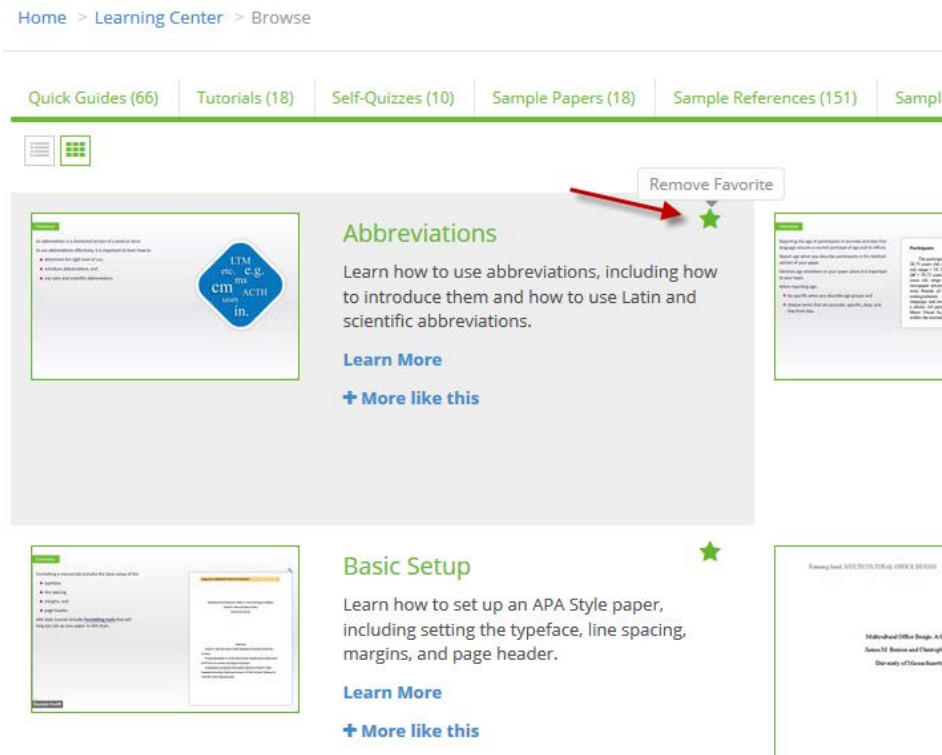
